The rose candle on the Advent wreath which we light today symbolizes the joy of 'Gaudete Sunday', the Third Sunday of Advent. 'Gaudete' is the Latin word meaning 'rejoice'. As our celebration of the Lord's nativity draws near, we open our hearts to the coming of the Lord in the flesh. We need also, in this time of Advent, to prepare ourselves for the Second Coming of Christ, when he will return to this world in all his glory and the whole universe will be made new. We can use the remaining weeks of Advent to cultivate, in our deepest selves, a sense of longing, of hoping, of desiring Christ's coming without knowing the day or the hour. Time, which is itself God's gift, is our chance to put ourselves at rights with God: to take up again the battle with whatever sins beset our lives; to make the firm commitment to set time aside for God in prayer, even in our busiest days; and to be courageous in our Catholic faith and proud that our religion continues to bring hope and joy to people's lives. **Mgr Matthew**
