PARISH FINANCE UPDATE 2025

Dear Parishioners

As you know, every Lent we have a financial appeal for the parish. This weekend, Nick Falcone, the chair of our parish finance committee, will give you an update on our financial position.

I am hugely grateful to all of you who contribute to our parish income, especially in these times when the cost of living continues to rise. As you see from Nick's figures, after several years of running a deficit, we have managed in the last year to return a modest surplus of just over £4,000. We have done this while at the same time raising nearly £8,000 for charitable causes.

The challenge we are now faced with is financing the parish's share of the Diocesan Levy which has risen from £15,000 in 2024 to £26,000 in 2025. The levy, which is raised on all parishes, is our contribution to the central costs of Diocesan administration. The increase in the levy means that we need to raise a further £11,000 to sustain our current surplus in 2025.

We are blessed to have a diverse and thriving community at St Thomas'. It is very much my hope and intention that every person who worships here feels welcomed and valued. Financial security is essential for our parish to continue to grow, and I would ask you all to consider whether you can increase your regular giving. Please consider taking out a standing order, especially if you are new to the parish. This is the most effective way of the parish having a stable and reliable income. If you are a UK tax-payer, please also consider gift aiding your contribution so that the parish can claim back the tax that is due on your gift.

Thank you all for your generosity, not just in finance but in so many areas of parish life.


