In our own small minds, we cannot always understand the ways of God or appreciate that God is working his purpose out across the whole of time – not just in the brief time in which we are alive. This was the lesson Job had to learn. Job, who had lost everything, had to understand that it is God, not man, who is all-seeing, all-knowing. It is God who is in charge, not us.

It is at times of great challenge in our lives that we need to re-affirm our trust in God. We may need to say in our prayers 'Lord, I do not know where I am going. I do not know where you are leading me. But I trust you and I will follow you in faith.' And when we are able in faith to 'let go' and really trust in God we experience a deep sense of relief, knowing that it is God, not us, who is in control.

What Jesus taught his disciples in the storm on the Sea of Galilee, and what he teaches us today, is that he is always with us. The risen Lord is always present to us. In the midst of our distress and fear, the Lord says 'Behold, I am with you always, until the end of time. Do not be afraid.' **Mgr Matthew**
